




Do not feed animals. It <u>harms</u> them.

ABOUT WEST RIDGE...

In the early 2000's, plans were underway to convert this wilderness into a retail area. Instead, a 2005 congressional earmark funded the acquisition of this land from Rosehill Cemetery. The acquired land was transferred to the Chicago Park District in 2011. The park district's renovation has transformed this wilderness into the West Ridge Nature Park (WRNP), an oasis of native flora and fauna.
